# Tech Support Scams: Don't Get Hooked!



Scammers are posing as tech support to trick you into thinking your computer is infected. Their goal? **Access your device and steal your money or identity.**

## Red Flags to Watch For

- Pop-ups or ads urging you to **call a number for help**
- Calls or texts claiming to be from a trusted company
- Requests for **remote access** to your computer
- Fake “virus scans” followed by demands to **transfer money**

## What You Should Know

- Real tech support **never calls, emails, or texts you first**
- Legitimate pop-ups **don't ask you to call a number**
- No bank or government agency will ever ask you to **move money to keep it safe**

## What to Do If You Were Scammed

- Shared personal info? Visit **IdentityTheft.gov** and change your passwords.
- Gave remote access? Update your security software or visit a repair shop.
- Report scams at **ReportFraud.ftc.gov**

## PENNIES BEING PHASED OUT

With the production of new pennies coming to an end in November 2025, the supply of pennies in circulation will begin to decrease. As a result, Blaze is no longer able to order pennies from the Federal Reserve, and we will be limited to the quantity we have on hand.

Here's what this means for Blaze members:

**Digital payments and transactions will not be affected.** Your Blaze Visa® Debit and Credit cards, mobile wallet, and other electronic payment methods will continue to process to the exact cent, just as they always have. There will be no rounding or any other changes to digital payments.

**Pennies at our branches may be limited.** Because we can no longer order pennies from the Federal Reserve, we will not be able to accept them or provide them during transactions moving forward.

**Blaze coin counters will not be able to accept pennies.**

**Cash transactions may be rounded.** Some local businesses may choose to round cash purchases to the nearest nickel. Each business will make its own decision, so this may vary from place to place.



Blaze Credit Union has again been recognized as one of **America's Best Regional Banks and Credit Unions 2026** by Newsweek and Plant-A Insights Group.

Nearly 9,000 regional banks and credit unions across the United States were examined. Only institutions operating in fewer than 30 states were included in their analysis. The analysis was supported by

survey data from more than 140,000 respondents, making America's Best Regional Banks and Credit Unions 2026 one of the largest studies of its kind.

The survey data was complemented by an analysis of more than 2.3 million social media reviews and over 80 million app store reviews from Apple and Google Play. The 500 highest-scoring banks and 500 highest-scoring credit unions received the America's Best designation.

## Skip-a-Pay

Skip-a-Pay requests can now be submitted via Blaze Digital Banking. To take advantage of this convenient option, log into digital banking and go to Account Services.

In the drop-down menu, select Skip-a-Payment. Then choose the loan you want to skip. If a loan does not show up, that loan is not eligible to be skipped. To review the eligibility requirements, visit [blazecu.com](http://blazecu.com).

For loans with a balance over \$10,000 there will be a \$25 participation fee. You can add the fee to the loan or withdraw it from your savings or checking account. If the balance is under \$9,999 there is no fee.

Finalize your request by reading and agreeing to the disclosure, then click Confirm.

# Inspiring Woman 2025 Jackye Whitner



Blaze is proud to share the recipient of its 2025 Inspiring Woman Award, Jackye Whitner. The award honors women who create lasting, positive change in their communities. The award presentation is a highlight of Inspiring Women, an annual event hosted by Blaze, meant to empower women by bringing together engaging speakers, unique experiences, and give back opportunities.

Raised on the Choctaw Reservation in Philadelphia, Mississippi, Jackye showed early drive, skipping two grades and entering Jackson State University at 17. In 1967, she enlisted in the U.S. Army, serving at multiple locations nationwide. She later made history in Minnesota as the first African American female Army recruiter in the Twin Cities and surrounding states, enlisting more than 200 young women into the Women's Army Corps.

After her honorable discharge, Jackye earned degrees in English and psychology counseling while working full time. She spent eleven years with St. Paul Public Schools in Adult Basic Education before retiring. A successful entrepreneur, she has also owned Nimble Fingers and Silver Thread, helping generations of young women feel confident through her designs.

Deeply committed to service, Jackye volunteers as a seamstress for Operation Glass Slipper and has been active in the St. Paul Winter Carnival for over 13 years, earning Volunteer of the Year in 2018. She and her husband have raised four children, are grandparents and great-grandparents, and have cared for more than 30 foster children. **Congratulations, Jackye!**
